- Nursing/Unit Director -

Current license as a registered nurse issued in the state of Illinois. BSN preferred. Masters Degree, a plus. Minimum five years experience in child and adolescent mental health/substance abuse treatment service. Must have the ability to plan, organize direct and evaluate the work of nursing and support staff and facility activities in a 24 hr. Adolescent Behavioral Health Unit, develop and conduct training, explain mental health laws and regulations, observe emotional and physical behavior of patients, evaluate and assess the need for mental health services, analyze a situation and adopt a course of action, demonstrate tact, diplomacy, patience and compassion. Communicate with people of diverse socioeconomic and ethnic groups and speak before groups. Proficiency in documenting patient findings. Must have basic computer skills. Strong organizational skills.
